BIOGRAPHY

Daan Brinkmann ('83) is a media artist from the Netherlands. His main preoccupation is creating installation art. His installations are either autonomous or interactional.

His interactional works are always based on the expressive potential of the spectator's body. Rather than the empirical elements within such a work being the artwork itself, they are often used as a means to achieve a new kind of social experience.

His autonomous installations counterbalance this approach. They strive to be in-depth explorations where the perception of light, sound, space and time becomes subject to itself.

In 2006 his work won the René Coelho Award at the Dutch institute for Media Arts.
